TRAVEL & DIRECTIONS



PAGE | 01 BY CAR

- From the M1, exit at junction 33, and then take the exit for A630.
- Follow the signs for Sheffield City Centre. The A630 (Sheffield Parkway) is a long dual carriageway lasting approximately 3-4 miles and will eventually take you to a large roundabout called 'Park Square'. (At the end of the A630 shortly after the 40 mph speed restriction road markings there is a speed camera).
- Just before the roundabout keep to the left. Then look for road markings for the A61S (3rd exit on roundabout).
- Follow A61S (Sheaf Street) and you will come to 2 sets of traffic lights, which you will continue to go through. You will come to a third set of traffic lights at which you will see the train station to your left. Continue through a 4th set of traffic lights and follow the road round as it bends to the right then left. You will pass a 'Subway' store on your left. Remain in the central lane and follow the road which after approximately 100 yards forks to the right, becoming the A61. Then continue travelling straight ahead remaining in the left hand lane.
- You will pass through a few sets of traffic lights until you reach a roundabout. (St Mary's Church on your left). Take your second exit (you will notice an 'Aldi Supermarket' on your left) and remain in the left hand lane (sign posted London Road Shopping). You come to a set of traffic lights, at which you should turn left onto London Road. Proceed on London Road for approximately meters.
- You will see a large restaurant on a corner to your left called "WasabiSabi', just after here turn right onto Sharrow Lane (Rossi's restaurant on the left on Sharrow Lane). Proceed up Sharrow Lane. At the traffic lights next to the Tesco Express store go straight over and count off 3 right turns. You will then see a crescent of houses on the right hand side recessed some way back off the pavement.
- The Barn Clinic is immediately after those houses on the right hand side. It is possible to park on the roadside, however there is also off-road parking for patients of The Barn Clinic, please park only in the designated area.





PAGE | 02 BY TRAIN

• The nearest and most frequented station to use would be Sheffield Train Station, which is based in the City Centre.

- Sheffield train station is directly linked to most major stations, and offers a frequent 2 hour train to/ from London St. Pancras, London & Manchester Internation Airport.
- On exiting Sheffield Train Station, you will find a taxi rank which you may choose to use to get to The Barn Clinic. The journey from the Station to The Barn Clinic is around 5-10 minutes, and should cost around £5-£7 in a Taxi.
- Uber taxi's also operate frequently in Sheffield. You can download Uber from your smartphone or device, by searching in the 'App Store'.
- Fares can often be slightly cheaper using Uber Taxis (around £3-£5), and you can make a payment directly from your bank account, if you prefer that over using cash.

FROM MANCHESTER AIRPORT

- The most convenient airport for International patients to use in Manchester Airport.
- Manchester Airport has its own train station, which operates an hourly direct train from Manchester Airport to Sheffield Train Station. (There are more frequent trains from Manchester Airport to Sheffield Train Station but this does involves changing stations during your journey).
- The direct train journey takes approximately 75 minutes. If you book in advance an each way ticket is around £10.00

PRIVATE AVIATION

- Private aircraft are able to land at Doncaster Sheffield Airport.

- The journey to The Barn Clinic from this airport is around 45 Minutes by car.
